Background: When Josephine enrolled in nursing school, she was the first person in her family to pursue education beyond high school. After graduation, she married her classmate's brother; together they raised four children.

While raising her family, Josephine practiced nursing in a variety of settings: neonatal intensive care, residential care for developmentally disabled adults, and office nursing with an ear/nose/throat specialist, among others. After retirement, she volunteered in a residential facility for teenage mothers and their infants.

Throughout her life, Josephine exemplified the truths and rewards of nursing. It is very hard and challenging work. At the same time, nursing knowledge and skills make it possible to comfort and treat the sick and teach people to stay well. The nursing profession enriches life for nurses and those for whom they care.

Aunt Jo, my mother's youngest sister, always inspired me. I have clear memories of Aunt Jo and her nursing school classmates visiting me when I was hospitalized for a few weeks as a child. Following her lead, when I enrolled in nursing school I was the first person in my family to pursue a college degree. My nursing career has been different from Aunt Jo's – I specialized in toxicology - but just as satisfying. This award is a small way of recognizing her enormous positive influence in my life.
