FLUVANNA FARM BUREAU WOMEN'S COMMITTEE

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. Applicant must be pursuing a career in or related to agriculture; i.e., horticulture, health sciences, animal sciences and forestry.
2. Applicant must be a resident of Fluvanna County.
3. Applicants may also be homeschooled or a student at an institution outside of Fluvanna County.
4. Applicants can only apply as a graduating senior.
5. Applicant must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
6. Applicants must submit teacher/employer recommendations along with a short 100+ word essay to include the following:
 - a. Current and future academic goals
 - b. Involvement in community organizations (4-H, FFA, volunteer efforts, church groups, etc.)
 - c. List of jobs held the past three years along with duties performed
 - d. List of involvement in extra-curricular activities (class or school offices, band, athletics, honors, awards, etc.)

FLUVANNA FARM BUREAU WOMEN'S COMMITTEE
SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Application will be due no later than the last Friday in March.
2. Acceptable schools of extended education include universities, community colleges and vocational/trade schools.
3. Application will accompany a short essay and letters of recommendations from teachers, employers, etc.
4. Application may be downloaded online or picked up at the Fluvanna Farm Bureau Office at 15905 River Road in Fork Union, VA. All applications must be submitted to the Farm Bureau office at the above address by the last Friday in March.
5. Applications will be viewed and selected by the women of the Farm Bureau Women's Committee. All applications will be kept confidential.
6. Recipients of the award will be notified by mail the first of May.
7. Recipients of the award will indicate how the check is to be issued. Scholarship funds may be earmarked for specific expenses i.e., books or supplies and made payable to the institution of choice and distributed upon notification of enrollment. If for some reason the student does not attend the institution, payment will be refunded to the Fluvanna Farm Bureau Women's Committee Scholarship fund.
