Applications are available through your high school counseling department and should be submitted no later than May 1, 2024..

The Rivanna Lions Club scholarship was established in the year 2000 and has been awarded each year to a senior accepted at a two- year college. The scholarship is called the Howard and Geraldine Kojan Memorial to honor 2 charter members of the club. A committee from the Rivanna Lions Club will accept applications and select two recipients for each \$500 scholarship. Students will be assessed on submission of the application form and a typed essay. They will need to supply information about school activities, membership in clubs and/or organizations, involvement in volunteer activities, participation in sports, interests and hobbies, employment history and future goals.
